

District Governor's Leo Contest

Time Frame: April 1, 2011 to March 31, 2012

PURPOSE: This award will reward Leo clubs which are consistently serving their community and school.

AWARD DESCRIPTION: The annual District Governor's Leo Contest has been established to encourage

1. Community Service
2. Inter-club and school activities
3. Attendance at district, state, and international functions
4. Support of Lion's District, State and International programs and the motto: "We Serve"

The award is also intended to improve the relationship between the clubs, the district, and LCI. Through participation in such activities, members and leadership will grow in ability as well as numbers.

Award will be presented at the 13-J District Convention Saturday April 21, 2012. Club award winner scores will be calculated by a point formula, tabulated by selected qualified Lions.

NOMINATION/SELECTION: Leo Clubs must be nominated for the award. This can and, in most cases, will be done by the club itself with a member designated to complete the nomination form and supply support materials. Nomination forms will be provided to clubs by January, 2012. The judges' decision will be based on the nomination form and support materials. **Nominations should be sent to DG Georgia Barber no later than March 31, 2012. Any nomination with a postmark later than March 31 or hand-delivered after March 31 will not be considered.**
