Last Meeting – June 7, 2010 - Mayor David Raizk delivers a State of the City Address – Mayor David Raizk was very positive about the outlook for our community given recent events that have transferred control of the Air Park from DHL back to our community. This is the pivotal event that can lead to our economic recovery. Recently our local paper ran an article indicating the Mayor had been approached by approximately 50 businesses that want to locate their company at our Air Park. The Mayor was candid indicating that some of those approaching him were not realistic opportunities and others were not presenting great employment opportunities. The strategy is to look for companies that would offer employment opportunities to thousands of employees. The best outcome would be 8 to 10 companies employing 500 to 700 each rather than one big company employing 5000. We want to be careful of repeating history putting all our eggs in one basket. Of course we would not overlook a big employer if the opportunity came from a stable company with a good business plan in an industry with some recession proof qualities. The Mayor then asked for our patience and indulgence to beautify the city and finish up the various road construction projects. The by-pass will pay huge dividends as trucks are diverted from downtown. Trucks do over a thousand times the damage, wear, and tear on roads as passenger cars. The Mayor takes tremendous pride in his community and his words were certainly healing to his fellow citizens. We are truly in this together.
